**A MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION DEFINING
PRIMARY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Ambulance Services and QRS shall respond to any manmade or natural disasters, life threatening emergencies, incidents that may cause property damage or loss, any type of fire-related incident that requires a medical service response, hazardous material incident, emergency medical incidents, or any other factor that causes an abnormality to day to day life or threatening situation. The Ambulance Services and QRS will also participate in non-emergency activities when requested. The QRS non-emergency activities shall be authorized by the Corsica Volunteer Fire Department fire chief or officer in charge with the fire chief's absence, and;

WHEREAS, the Ambulance Services will be self supportive financially. The Borough of Corsica reserves the right to provide funding to the Ambulance Services if they so desire, and;

WHEREAS, QRS personnel shall be members of the Corsica Volunteer Fire Department, and be in accordance with the bylaws of that organization;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Corsica, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania; and IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ENACTED by the authority of the same as follows:

Primary Emergency Medical Service for the Borough of Corsica, County of Jefferson, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, shall be defined under this resolution adopted by the undersigned municipal authorities on the date below written. All other previous agreements, resolutions and/or ordinances are hereby nullified with the adoption of this resolution, that defines the **Primary Emergency Medical Services Response Agency**.

Now, therefore it be resolved that, the primary responding Emergency Medical Service for the Borough of Corsica shall be the Jefferson County EMS Station 90 located in the Township of Pine Creek, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania.

Council for the Borough of Corsica officially recognizes the Jefferson County EMS Station 90 as the primary Emergency Medical Response Agency for the citizens, property owners, and visitors of the Borough of Corsica. And, be it understood that these services do provide the same services to other municipalities. In the event that services are not available from the Jefferson County EMS Station 90, the Jefferson County 911 Center will determine the next closest available service or services to dispatch.

**A MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION DEFINING
PRIMARY FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Corsica Volunteer Fire Department (hereinafter "Fire Company") shall respond to any manmade or natural disasters, life threatening emergencies, incidents that may cause property damage or loss, any type of fire-related incident that requires a fire service response, hazardous material incident, emergency medical incidents, or any other factor that causes an abnormality to day to day life or threatening situation. The Fire Company will also participate in non-emergency activities when requested. The Fire Company's non-emergency activities shall be authorized by the Corsica Volunteer Fire Department fire chief or officer in charge with the fire chief's absence, and;

WHEREAS, the Fire Company will be self supportive financially. The Borough of Corsica reserves the right to provide funding to the Fire Company if they so desire and is responsible for providing workman's compensation on responders of the Fire Company, and;

WHEREAS, the Fire Company shall maintain and purchase their own equipment and facilities.

WHEREAS, the Fire Company shall elect their own officers in accordance with their company bylaws and govern the fire company in accordance with the same bylaws and standard operating procedures, and;

WHEREAS, the fire chief elected by the Fire Company shall serve as incident commander for all incidents occurring with the Borough of Corsica. with the fire chief's absence, the chain of command procedures according the Fire Company's bylaws will dictate succession, and;

WHEREAS, the fire chief shall also serve as the assistant fire marshal, being responsible for investigating and reporting fires that occur within the Borough of Corsica.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Corsica, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania; and IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ENACTED by the authority of the same as follows:

Primary fire protection for the Borough of Corsica, County of Jefferson, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, shall be defined under this resolution adopted by the undersigned municipal authorities on the date below written. All previous agreements, resolutions and/or ordinances are hereby nullified with the adoption of this resolution, that defines the **Primary Fire Protection Response Agency**.



The Council of the Borough of Corsica officially recognizes the Corsica Volunteer Fire Company as the primary fire response agency for the citizens, property owners, and visitors of the Borough of Corsica. And, be it understood that the Corsica Volunteer Fire Department provides first due protection to the Borough of Corsica, in the County of Jefferson, within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and provides assistance to other municipalities when called upon for mutual aid services.


