ORDINANCE NUMBER 60

AN ORDINANCE ORDAINING PORTIONS
OF SCHOOL STREET AND WATER STREET
IN THE BOROUGH OF CORSICA

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Corsica, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the authority of the same as follows:

1. The following described streets are hereby laid out and opened and are to named School Street and Water Street as indicated in the following description:

BEGINNING at a point in the Northern right of way of State Route No. 322, said point being located North $81^{\circ} 31' 40''$ East 205.16 feet from an existing iron bar, the Southeast corner of Richard Greenwood, said point of beginning is also South $87^{\circ} 56' 24''$ West 404.06 feet from the intersection of center lines of Church Street and State Route No. 322; thence from said point of beginning North $9^{\circ} 32' 38''$ West along the center line of School Street 387.77 feet to a point where the center line of School Street intersects the center line of Water Street; thence North $84^{\circ} 48' 43''$ East along the center line of Water Street 440.00 feet to a point in the Western right of way of Church Street, said point is North $1^{\circ} 44' 00''$ West 409.45 feet from the intersection of the center lines of Church Street and the State Route 322.

The above survey was performed along the center line of existing cartway of School Street and Water Street by Richard E. Weidow, Professional Land Surveyor, in October, 1990. Both of the above described streets are to have a 24-foot right of way.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED at a special meeting of the Council of the Borough of Corsica, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania, on the 27th day of December, 1990.
